



THE INSTITUTE OF QUARRYING

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION FORM

FELLOW

The higher corporate grade for those who have the necessary qualifications and senior managerial experience. This grade carries the right to the designatory letters FIQ.



MEMBER

The standard grade of membership for those with an approved qualification and basic line management or specialist experience in the industry. Designatory letters MIQ.



TECHNICAL

This category is for those persons with specific technical skills that are essential to the industry or contractors who provide support to the industry in technical functions



ASSOCIATE

This category is for those persons having experience of the industry but without formal qualifications and those working towards a qualification or gaining experience



STUDENT

A subsidised grade for students who are working for qualifications to enable them to proceed to a higher level. Upgrading is required as soon as the specified qualifications and/or experience have been attained

Progression through the grades of membership is shown above, however direct entry into any grade is possible, provided that the applicant has the necessary qualifications and experience (see overleaf).

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

CORPORATE GRADES

FELLOW

- a) must be employed in the extraction and processing of minerals, including secondary minerals, recycled materials, crushed and dimension stone.
- b) must have suitable qualifications and experience as determined in the absolute discretion of the Council
- c) must have met the Membership requirements (see below)
- d) must have an appropriate level of experience in the inspectorate as determined in the absolute discretion of the Council.

ASSOCIATE

- a) have passed the Professional Examination of the Institute
OR
- b) have obtained an approved technical or administrative qualification

GUIDELINES

"Industry": the extraction and processing of surface minerals including crushed and dimension stone, sand and gravel, clays, opencast, coal, alluvial, pit and strip operations, asphalt, cement, ready-mixed concrete and concrete products, plus companies supplying goods and services to the quarrying industry

Mines and quarries inspectors, drilling and blasting contractors, lecturers in quarrying at recognised colleges, technical consultants and minerals planning officers are regarded as being employed within the industry.

"Experience in the industry": full-time employment in the industry including industrial periods of approved courses.

"Exempting qualification": an approved technical or administrative qualification

"Technical qualification": An academic qualification approved by Council at not less than Diploma Level appropriate to the person's discipline, e.g.. HNC Civil Engineering, HND Mechanical engineering BSc Geology

"Administrative qualification": an academic qualification approved by Council at not less than Diploma Level appropriate to the person's discipline, e.g.. HNC Business Studies Diploma in Management Studies, BA Town and Country Planning, MBA.

NON-CORPORATE GRADES

MEMBER

- a) must be employed in the quarrying industry
- b) must have suitable qualifications and experience as determined in the absolute discretion of the Council
- c) have passed the Professional Examination of the Institute or possess an exempting qualification
- d) must have an appropriate level of experience in the inspectorate as determined in the absolute discretion of the Council.

TECHNICAL

- a) be employed In the industry or employed as a contractor in the industry.
- b) possess a qualifying qualification, or combination of qualifications relevant to employment
- c) have completed a period of training and have experience in the industry, not less than one year in a technical position.

STUDENT

- a) must be engaged in a course of study or training relating to the industry
